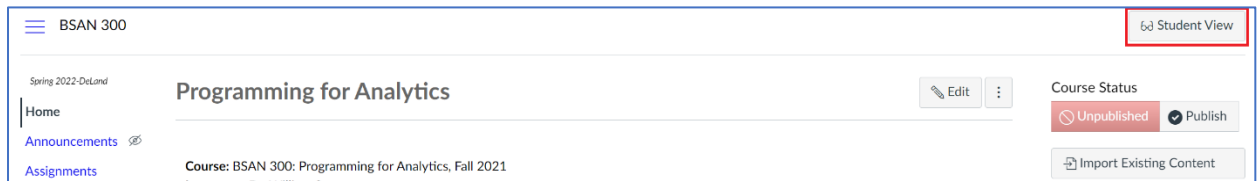
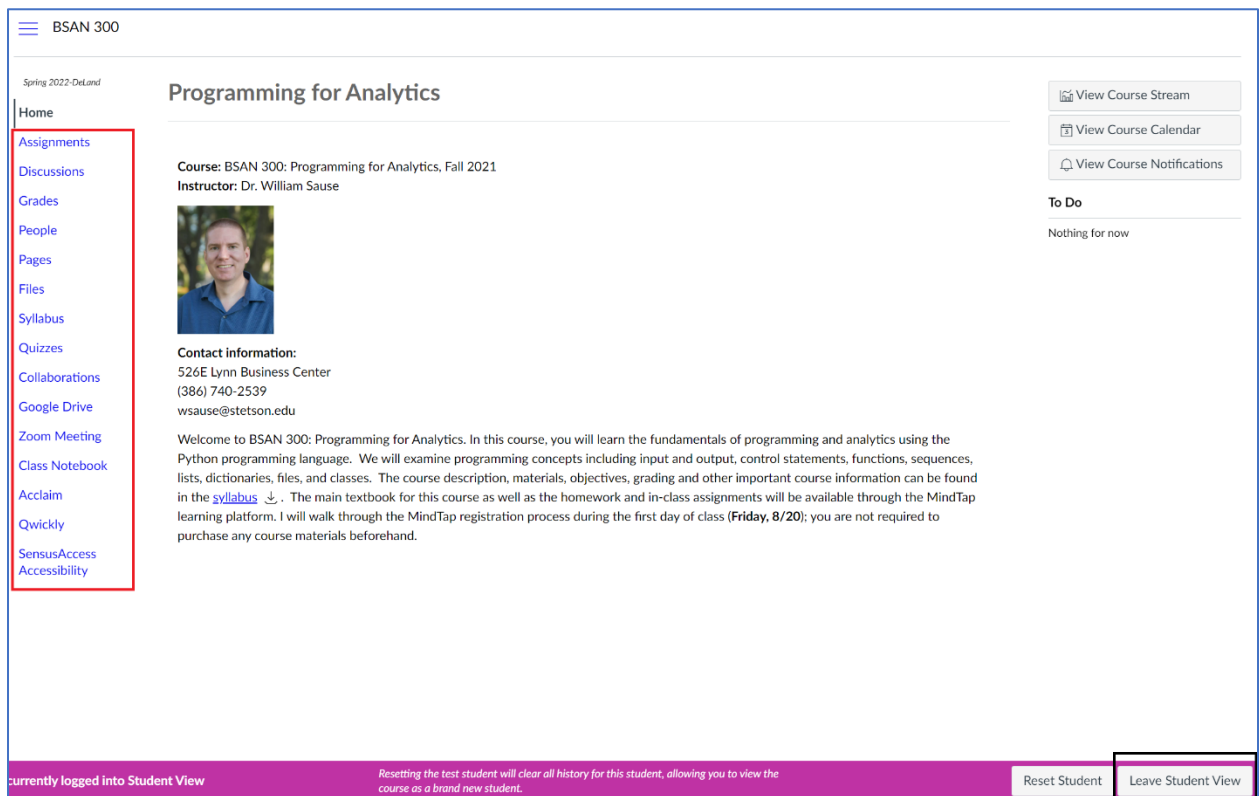


How can I customize my course navigation in Canvas?

1. Clicking the “Student View” button from the home page will display the course as the student will see it.



2. By default, there are several menu options available to the student which you may not want them to access. To leave the student view, click the “Leave Student View” button in the lower right corner.



3. To select the menu options that you would like to be available to the student, click the “Settings” link on the navigation menu and select the “Navigation” tab.
