


## How can I accommodate a specific student to allow extra time to take a “classic quiz” test online when requested through ASC?

1. To adjust quiz settings to meet student accommodations, you must first publish the quiz. From the quiz summary page, click the “Publish” button. The “Related Items” panel will then appear on the right. From the “Related Items” panel, click the “Moderate This Quiz” link.


