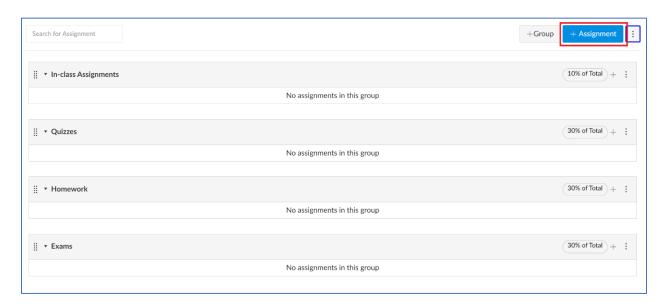
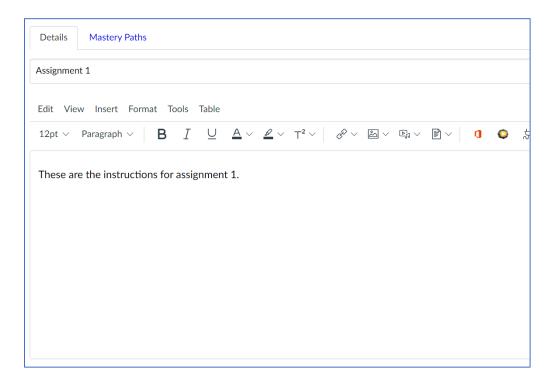
How do I create an assignment in Canvas?

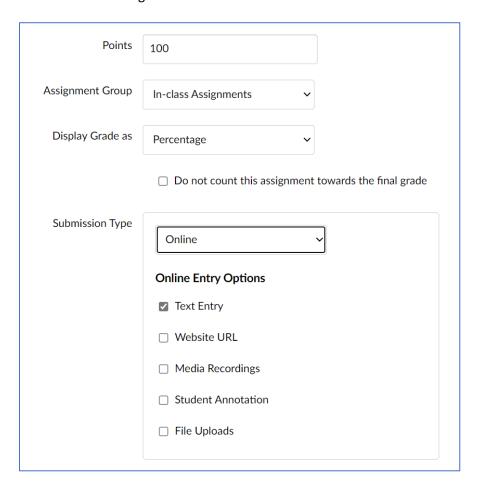
1. To create an assignment, click the "+ Assignment" button on the right side of the assignments page.



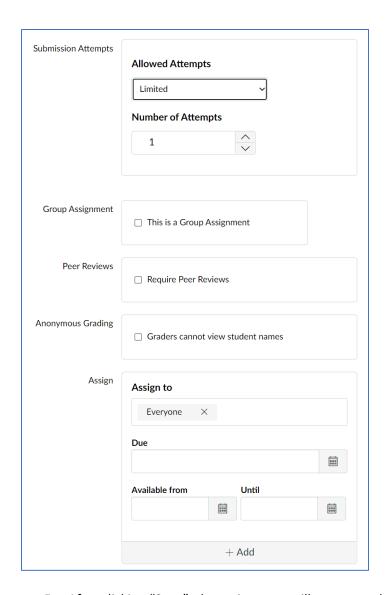
2. On the new assignment page, enter the name of the assignment and add instructions to the rich content editor.



3. Enter the number of points for this assignment then select the assignment group to place the assignment under. In the "Display Grade as" dropdown, select how you would like the grade to appear in the gradebook. The "Submission Type" area contains a dropdown to select the type of submission the assignment will be. This could be a paper submission or no submission at all. However, if you would like the student to submit a file through Canvas, select "Online." Online entry options include a file upload or a text entry where the student can enter their text directly into the assignment.



4. The "Submission Attempts" area contains a dropdown to select if the assignment is to have unlimited or a specified number of limited attempts. You can also select if the assignment is a "Group Assignment", requires "Peer Reviews" (where a student can provide feedback on another student's assignment), or allows "Anonymous Grading" (where the student's name is not displayed when grading the assignment). Lastly, the "Assign" area allows you to assign to specific students or to the entire class, and to enter a due date and the dates the assignment will be available to students.



5. After clicking "Save", the assignment will appear under the selected assignment group.
