Offering discounted faculty and staff meal plans.

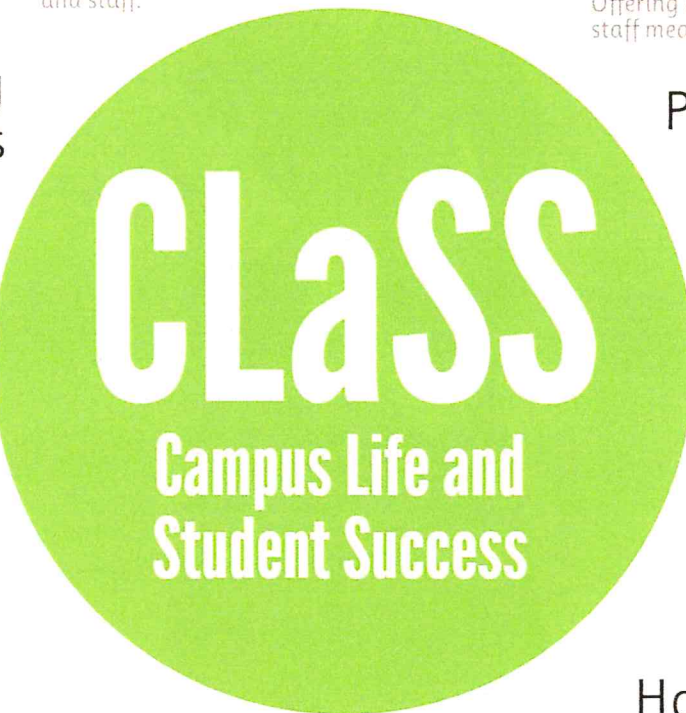
Community Standards
